1 **I. GENERAL PROVISIONS**

2 Nothing in this order is intended to or does supersede any prior Case Management Order in
3 this matter, unless otherwise noted. See Case Management Order No. 1 dated March 17, 2025 (“CMO
4 1”), Case Management Order dated April 18, 2025 (“CMO 2”), Case Management Orders dated May
5 15, 2025 (“CMO 3” and “CMO 4”), and Case Management Order Dated June 2, 2025 (“CMO 5”),
6 Case Management Order Dated July 10, 2025 (“CMO 6”), and Case Management Order Dated
7 August 19, 2025 (“CMO 7”), Case Management Order Dated September 19, 2025 (“CMO 8”), Case
8 Management Order Dated October 6, 2025 (“CMO 9”), Case Management Order Dated December
9 18, 2025 (“CMO 10”), Case Management Order dated February 9, 2026 (“CMO 11”), Case
10 Management Order Dated April 7, 2026 (“CMO 12”), Case Management Order Dated April 8, 2026
11 (“Amended CMO 8”), and Case Management Order Dated May 29, 2026 (“CMO 13”). Nothing in
12 this Order alters any party’s obligations under any applicable Protective Order.

13 **II. MOTION TO BE RELIEVED AS COUNSEL**

14 In matters where an Individual Plaintiff is represented by more than one law firm (a co-
15 counsel relationship) and a motion to be relieved as counsel is being made by all firms, a joint
16 motion on behalf of all firms may be filed.

17 **III. UNREPRESENTED AND SELF REPRESENTED INDIVIDUAL PLAINTIFFS**

18 Upon entry of an order on a motion to be relieved as counsel, at the time that the respective
19 counsel is giving notice to the former client, they shall also include a letter directing the former
20 client to the BrownGreer website where they can obtain copies of the Court’s CMOs and important
21 upcoming dates. A template of such a letter is attached hereto as **Exhibit A**.

22 Liaison Counsel for Individual Plaintiffs and Counsel for Defendants shall work together to
23 keep a list of unrepresented and self-represented Individual Plaintiffs. Such unrepresented and self-
24 represented Individual Plaintiffs shall be given notice by mail and email, to the extent counsel has
25 current contact information, of all Case Management Conferences and hearings in the Lead Case.
26 as set forth in the July 22, 2026 minute order.

26 **IV. INDIVIDUAL PLAINTIFF SUCCESSOR-IN-INTEREST**

27 Any substitution of a successor in interest for a deceased Individual Plaintiff must be by
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1 stipulation and comply with the requirements of Code of Civil Procedure § 377.32, including the
2 submission of the required declaration. The stipulation need only be signed by counsel for the
3 respective Individual Plaintiff and counsel for Defendant.

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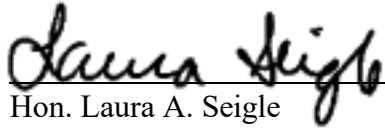
